Since 1993 Assistant Physician at Department of Clinica Medica (Ancona University Medical School), in a large Teaching Hospital (Ospedali Riuniti di Ancona). He is responsible for the care of 12 in-patients affected by severe immunological, rheumatological and other conditions (Internal Medicine) and of a large number of out-patients afferent to ambulatories and Day-Hospital service.

In particular, since 1992 he has been responsible for the Ambulatory of Rheumatology handling about 350 adult patients affected by Rheumatoid Arthritis, 150 affected by psoriatic arthritis, 100 affected by other inflammatory arthritides and spondylitis, 30 affected by Systemic Lupus Erythematosus, 30 affected by Systemic Sclerosis, 40 affected by other systemic connectivitis and 30 affected by systemic vasculitis. Almost 250 out of these cases are currently treated with biological drugs or are undergoing experimental treatments (randomized controlled trials or prospective cohort studies).

Moreover from 2007 he covers the position of responsible for Clinical Governance Measures in the Department of Internal Medicine, involved in projecting and conducting activities of clinical audit, clinical guidelines implementation, performance controls.

He is actually one of the 5 members of the "nucleo di valutazione" (committee for performance evaluation), in charge for the evaluation of performances of all medical and paramedical professionals working in the Ospedali Riuniti of Ancona.

He is deeply involved in teaching activities both in the field of Immuno-Rheumatology and of Evidence-Based Medicine and Clinical Governance (see below for details).

Areas of interest and research activities

Main areas of interest:

1. Clinical Immunology

Beside the above mentioned clinical activities, Giovanni Pomponio has been involved in teaching projects for Specialist Doctors, General Physicians and Nurses, both within Masters organized by Ancona, Roma La Sapienza and Milan University, and courses held by professional associations, hospitals, industries. He has been also consultant for the three largest pharmaceutical industries which operate in this field (Roche, Pfizer, Abbvie). Furthermore he has been involved in several research projects, both clinical and basic science. The results of these researches have been published in international books and as papers in peer-reviewed indexed journals

2. Wound Care

In collaboration with The Italian Nursing Association for the Study of Cutaneous Lesions (AISLeC) from more than 10 years Giovanni Pomponio has been involving in designing original trials and integrative documents investigating the efficacy of different intervention in preventing and treating skin ulcers. In particular he coordinated and provided methodological support to Expert- and Evidence-based consensus conferences about the best choice of pressure reliefs devices, the clinical use of silver containing agents, how to manage biofilm in chronic ulcers, how to conduct clinical trials on infected wounds, how to manage heel pressure ulcers (ongoing).

3. Evidence-based Medicine (EBM) and Clinical Governance

Since 1996 Giovanni Pomponio has been coordinating the group for evidence-based medicine in the department of Internal Medicine in the Ancona hospital. In 2010 he has been nominated responsible for the Clinical Governance activities (clinical audit, control of performance, etc.) for the Department of Internal Medicine. From early 2000's he wrote several books for training of Physicians and Nurses. Moreover he has been called by several Universities (Ancona, Milan, Rome, Varese, Perugia, Chieti, Verona/Trento) to organize and conduct Masters and Courses about advanced EBM tools and techniques, Tools and projects for the Clinical Governance, Health Technology Assessment and Clinical Methodology (see below for a list of the main events). Similarly, he made teaching activities on the behalf of medical and nursing professional associations. Moreover he designed and conducted four formal Consensus Conferences

Publications

He wrote 11 books (9 as first Author) in the fields of Rheumatology, Clinical Methodology and Evidence-based Medicine. Moreover he wrote 14 chapters in Italian and International books. He was co-Author of 41 papers published in international peer-reviewed journals indexed by Pubmed and 46 papers published in not indexed Italian Journals (see the list enclosed)
